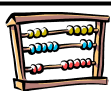


Mathematics



Numeracy

Students will continue in Maths group across Years 5 and 6 for three sessions each week focussing on the Number and Algebra stands of the Australian Curriculum.

The focus this term will be:

- Multiplication and division
- Prime and composite numbers
- Problem solving

Measurement

- Length, perimeter and area

Geometry

- Representing events and outcomes in a tree diagram
- Connecting likelihood to fractions, decimals and percentages

Environment Centre/Science:

In Chemistry, the Year 6s will be learning about chemical and physical changes. They will learn how to identify what type of change a material is undergoing and what sorts of observations are important. The students will be learning about the chemical change of rusting.

We are looking forward to another ten weeks packed with exciting learning and leadership opportunities this term. Students will build on previous skills and also take on new knowledge in different learning areas.

In Term 3, we will work towards a range of exciting leadership activities. Students will continue their planning as part of Year 6 Parliament within their portfolios and consider events and changes that could be implemented around the school. Additionally, students will begin planning for Market Day which has always proven to be a fun whole-of-school event and a great fundraiser for Year 6 Graduation.

FLIP groups will also be continuing in Term 3. Student will participate in a new group and the program will run every second Friday in the odd weeks.

Geography - Students will learn about the characteristics of diverse places in different locations. They will learn about cultural, economic and population diversity and the impact these have on groups of people around the world. Students will also learn about how maps and data can explain diversity in different regions.

Business and Economics - Students will take on their learning as part of Market Day. They will learn about identifying needs and gaps in the market where a product can be introduced. Students will make informed decisions about how limiting expenditure can maximise profits for business.

Health/P.E.

Students will plan and run lessons with their peers that focus on improving a fundamental motor skill.

Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.

This term students will be revising their knowledge and developing skills in writing narratives and persuasive writing. They will learn about how language choices can impact audiences and add emphasis to their writing. Students will continue developing planning, drafting, proofreading and editing skills.

Students will engage whole class and guided reading activities. They will learn about different strategies that will help them retain their understanding of what they read.

Students will continue to develop their skills in the elements of writing, including spelling, vocabulary, grammar and punctuation.

Japanese: During Term 3 year 6 will continue making their own exciting travel brochures and then make their own advertisements and plays to promote a chosen place of travel. We will look carefully at verb conjunctions while asking and answering questions in the Japanese language. We will also continue to revise and build our hiragana skills and practise sight word recognition with basic vocabulary. Les Longford
