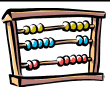


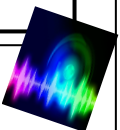
Mathematics

English



Our daily literacy block will continue to focus on reading, writing and spelling, speaking, viewing and listening. The students will have the opportunity this term to develop an understanding of procedural texts. They will continue to build on their recount skills. Students will be encouraged to use correct punctuation and grammar in their writing to help structure their sentences.

Year 1 students will also read a variety of texts; participate in activities such as independent reading, reading with and to teachers and working in guided reading groups.

The students' knowledge and understanding of sight words and letter patterns will continue to be developed. The children will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of sight words and letter patterns. Students will consolidate their spelling by participating in a weekly spelling test.
