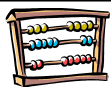


Mathematics



Numeracy

Students will continue in Maths group across Years 5 and 6 for three sessions each week focussing on the Number and Algebra stands of the Australian Curriculum.

The focus this term will be:

- Multiplication and division
- Prime and composite numbers
- Problem solving

Geometry

- Making 3D prisms and pyramids

Statistics and Probability

- Chance experiments with small and large numbers of trials
- Connecting likelihood to fractions, decimals and percentages

Environment Centre/Science:

This Year 6 will be continuing their chemistry program. To help in understanding the difference between scientific opinion and scientific evidence, the Year 6 students will be learning about the concept of geoengineering and its links to chemistry.

They will work in groups to find a technological solution to a problem that exists for some people in the community. The challenge will involve collaboration, research and ingenuity with available resources as well as exploring key design, make and appraise processes. It should be a fun and exciting task and it will be very interesting to see what our budding inventors build and present.

Health/P.E.

Students will continue to participate in P.E. We will be developing a deeper understanding and learning about mental health and recognising strategies on how improve we can improve it.

Visual Art: Students will look at how important messages relating to society can be depicted in art.

Dance: Students will take part of dance as part of the end-of-year concert.

English



Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.

This term students will continue revising their knowledge and developing skills in different writing genres. They will learn about how language choices can impact audiences and add emphasis to their writing. Students will continue developing planning, drafting, proofreading and editing skills.

Students will engage whole class and guided reading activities. They will learn about different strategies that will help them retain their understanding of what they read.

Students will continue to develop their skills in the elements of writing, including spelling, vocabulary, grammar and punctuation.

Japanese:

Konnichiwa! We are exploring the world of verbs this term, learning verb vocabulary and how to change the tense with different suffixes. Earlier this year students researched places in Japan. We will use the new verb sentence structures to write a 'blog' in Japanese about visiting Japan.
