


Mathematics



This term year 4 will investigate and create patterns. Looking at formation and how patterns can be represented through multiplication. Students will learn to determine unknown quantities using addition and subtraction.

We will also be investigating angles and symmetry and measuring mass and capacity.

Inquiry

This term year 4 will focus on History for our integrated unit of work. We will investigate First Contact between the British First Fleet and Indigenous Australians. This unit will link to our writing topics. We will go to Lanyon Homestead on an excursion also.

The Arts - Music and Media Arts

Students will listen to and compare different music as well as compose short percussion pieces identifying and use specific rhythms.

Physical Education

In PE this term, students will finish an exploration of invasion games by playing an indigenous running and passing game called Buroinjin. This was a ball game played by the Kabi Kabi people of south Queensland. The game was played with a ball made of kangaroo skin, which was called a buroinjin. Students will continue to use a "games sense" approach to learn about the tactics and strategies involved in invasion games by focussing on this game. Later in the term students will commence a mini gymnastics unit focussing on balance, body awareness and movement patterns.

English



Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.

This term students will be developing skills in **information texts and recounts** which will link to our History unit of work. Students will continue to develop planning, drafting, proofreading and editing skills. Classes will engage in regular, independent, and cooperative reading sessions. They will also participate in explicit teaching of grammar and punctuation.

To develop their spelling strategies, students will engage in a range of learning opportunities including 'Words Their Way' which is targeted at their stage of development and vocabulary discussions in class.

In speaking, students will participate in Rostrum.

Environment Centre/Science:

In chemistry the Year 4 students will be investigating the properties of natural and processed materials. They will be investigating the environmental impacts of packaging and if there are realistic sustainable options.
