

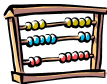

Mathematics



This year mathematics will occur in two parts. Year 1 and 2 students will be placed in a maths group for three sessions each week focussing on the area of number. Your child's maths teacher will be assessing and reporting on number while the class teacher will cover measurement and geometry and statistics and probability. Our focus for term 1 is 2 and 3 dimensional shapes. Our mathematics program supports students in developing and applying a range of strategies to solve problems. Where appropriate we will use real-life learning experiences and hands-on activities to further engage our learners.

Physical Education

Year 1s will participate in cooperative and modified games to improve fundamental skills, develop self-awareness and sportsmanship. All students will continue to participate in gross motor rotations.

History

Our integrated inquiry unit this term will be from the *History* curriculum, titled **Moments in Time**. Through this inquiry students will gain the understanding that some aspects of family life have changed over time but some have remained the same. The students will have opportunities to describe some personal and family events that have significance and are important to them. They will learn how celebrations and commemorations help us connect to the past and how connecting to the past informs our future.



Environment Centre/Science:

In Earth and Space science, the Year 1 students will learn about daily, seasonal and yearly changes in their surroundings. Students will learn that seasons are different in different places and be shown how Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people classify seasonal changes. They will investigate natural, managed and constructed features of their environment and observe how these may change over time. They will create mini-gardens using natural and processed materials and explore how classroom or garden environments may affect them. Kate Elliott

English

Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.
English

Our daily literacy block focuses on the components of reading, writing, spelling, speaking and listening. The main writing genre focus will be on recounts. Students will write recounts about their weekends and any special events that occur through the year, drawing on their first hand experiences to stimulate ideas.

Students in Year 1 will read and listen to a variety of texts. They will participate in whole group, independent reading and in guided reading groups. Grammar to be covered this term includes: capital letters, sentences, nouns, alphabetical order and plurals.

Japanese:

Konnichiwa! The topic for this term is "My Class". Children learn the language of the classroom including greetings and phrases such as asking for help. They will learn the words for classroom objects and become familiar with classroom instructions in Japanese. Through all lessons students will be exposed to the different written scripts, particularly 'hiragana'. Lessons involve games, songs, stories, role-plays and more.
