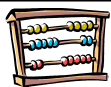


## Mathematics

### Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.

This term students will be finalising their work with informative text and will then explore writing to inform through invites, letters and messages.

Reading remains a key focus throughout this term and students will be provided with opportunities to further develop their skills in areas such as retell and identifying implied meaning.

Students will continue to develop their knowledge of grammar and punctuation through explicit teaching sessions, small group work and individual activities. Spelling activities will also continue targeting the stage of individual development.

### The Arts-Music

The students will continue to explore and recognise elements of music including dynamics, pitch, and rhythm patterns. They will practise singing, playing instruments and improvising music using these elements. The students will create, perform and record compositions by selecting and organising sounds, tempo and volume. They will identify intended purposes and meaning as they listen to a variety of music and make comparisons.
