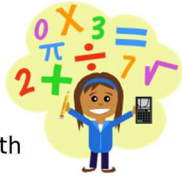

Biology – The needs of living things

Throughout the term students will be looking at survival needs across the curriculum in our unit of inquiry. This will include exploring the needs of a variety of Australian animals. Students will investigate and compare the needs of different living things. There will be a focus on classifying Australian animals and their unique characteristics and needs. Students will investigate animal habitats, how they meet animals' needs and how they can be protected. Students will also explore Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people's connections to animals and the land. We look forward to our first Kindergarten Excursion to the National Zoo and Aquarium.

Health/P.E.

Students continue to participate in Gross Motor sessions on a Friday. Fundamental motor skills practised this term include: throwing, catching, bouncing, balancing, jumping, kicking, leaping and skipping. We continue social and emotional learning through The Friendly Schools Plus values program and incidental conversations when issues arise. This term students will also have road safety and protective behaviour discussions with special guest; Kenny Koala and participate in the school Cross Country and **Athletics Carnivals.**
