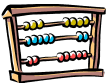


Mathematics



Numeracy

Students will continue Maths groups across Year 3 and 4 for three sessions each week focusing on the Number and Algebra strands of the Australian Curriculum.

The focus this term will be:

- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication/Division

- Time

Science: Chemistry

In chemistry the Year 3 students will be learning how a change in temperature can change the state of a material. They will learn that different materials respond differently to temperature changes and will investigate melting points of a variety of liquids. Students will work in groups to observe changes in materials and will be expected to record their observations using formal measurements.

Welcome to Term 2!

History

Students will be identifying individuals, events and aspects of the past that have had a significance on the present. They will be identifying and describing aspects of their community that have changed and remained the same over time.

Students will sequence information about events and the lives of individuals in chronological order. They pose questions about the past and locate and collect information from sources (written, physical, visual, oral) to answer these questions.

They will be analysing information to identify a point of view.

Digital Technology

Students will develop digital technology skills using Google Classrooms and Google Apps for education.

Students will continue to participate in the Friendly Schools Plus - Values Program.

Motor skills such as movement, throwing, catching, balance and coordination will continue to be a focus for students this term as we prepare for the athletics carnival.



The Arts-Music

This term, the students will explore the elements of music including dynamics, pitch, and rhythm patterns. They will practise singing, playing instruments and improvising music using these elements. The students will create, perform and record compositions by selecting and organising sounds, tempo and volume. Students will continue to develop their knowledge of grammar and punctuation through explicit teaching sessions, small group work and individual activities. Spelling activities will also continue targeting the stage of individual development.
