


Mathematics



Numeracy

Students will be placed in a Maths group across Year 5 and 6 for three sessions each week. Groups will be focussing on the Number and Algebra stands of the Australian Curriculum.

The focus this term will be:

- Multiplication and division
- Fractions, decimals and percentages

Measurement

- Volume/Capacity/length and Time

Geometry

- Properties of 3D shapes



Environment Centre/Science:

In chemistry the Year 5 students will learn the properties of solids, liquids and gases and why temperature changes can change the state of a material. They will learn how energy affects the atoms and molecules that make various materials. Students will work in groups to plan and conduct experiments on how heat energy can affect the viscosity of liquids.

Science

This term we will be learning about the Earth as a component within the solar system. Students will use models for investigating systems at astronomical scales. They will identify stable and dynamic aspects of systems and learn how to look for patterns and relationships between components of systems. They will develop ways to explain the patterns they observe.

Students will play a variety of team games with a focus on team based skills. Friendly Schools Plus Values Program: Term focus - Social awareness and relationship skills.

Music: Band (Tuesday and Friday)

Media Arts: Successful selling:- The producing and filming of a fresh food commercial.

Visual Arts: This term, students will take a brief look at artists such as Vincent van Gogh and their impressionist style. We will discuss the use of line and swirls that create a sense of movement in the landscape artworks. Students will gain an understanding of the influences and intentions portrayed in impressionist paintings to inspire them for their own creativity. They will look at the ideas and work of a modern day artist and use stencilling, watercolours, sponges and collage to create a fascinating layered art display.

English



Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.

This term students will be revising their knowledge and consolidating their skills in writing information reports and descriptive writing.

Students will continue to develop planning, drafting, proofreading and editing skills.

Students will engage in regular, independent, shared, guided and cooperative reading sessions.

Students will also participate in explicit teaching of grammar and punctuation.

To develop their spelling strategies, students will engage in a range of learning opportunities including BEE Spelling, targeting their stage of development and vocabulary discussions in class.

Japanese: During Term 3 year 5 will continue making their own exciting travel brochures and then make their own advertisements and plays to promote a chosen place of travel. We will look carefully at verb conjunctions while asking and answering questions in the Japanese language. We will also continue to revise and build our hiragana skills and practise sight word recognition with basic vocabulary.
