

Mathematics

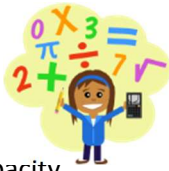

English

Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.

Learning will happen through a variety of small group and whole class reading and writing activities.



Music

They will practise a repertoire of chants, songs and rhymes. The students will have the opportunity to create their own compositions. Digital Technology
