Inquiry

This term year 4 will focus on History for our integrated unit of work. We will investigate First Contact between the First Fleet and Indigenous Australians. This unit will link to our writing topics (information reports and recounts).

Environment Centre/Science:

In chemistry the Year 4 students will be investigating the properties of natural and processed materials. They will be investigating the environmental impacts of packaging and if there are realistic sustainable options.

Visual Arts

Charcoal has an X factor. There is just something about it. It is messy, unpredictable and the students in year 4 love it because it is a tool they probably don't have at home. This term by using Charcoal allows the year 4 students to achieve dark values quickly and blend with ease. Year 4 will learn how to sketch and explore a range of values and mark making. English



Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Viewing.

This term students will be developing skills in **information texts and recounts** which will link to our History unit of work. Students will continue to develop planning, drafting, proofreading and editing skills. Classes will engage in regular, independent, and cooperative reading sessions. To develop their spelling strategies, students will engage in a range of learning opportunities including 'Words Their Way' which is targeted at their stage of development and vocabulary discussions in class. In speaking, students will participate in Rostrum.

Physical Education

In PE this term, students will finish an exploration of invasion games by playing an indigenous running and passing game called Buroinjin. This was a ball game played by the Kabi Kabi people of south Queensland. The game was played with a ball made of kangaroo skin, which was called a buroinjin.

Later in the term students will commence a mini gymnastics unit focussing on balance, body awareness and movement patterns.
