A hands on approach to numeracy learning is continued in our classrooms this term.

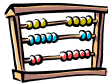
The concepts that we will be covering this term include:

English

Reading, writing, listening, speaking and viewing.



The English curriculum will continue to expose the children to a wide range of activities. Students will engage in regular independent, shared, modelled and guided reading experiences. We will continue to focus on letter recognition, sounds, sentence construction, reading and exploring a range of texts.

Students will specifically focus on writing to inform. We will look closer at information reports, 5 senses writing pieces and recounts. Recognising and reading high frequency words, referred to as Magic 100 words will continue through word work activities and can also be practised at home.

Geography

Kindergarten students will be exploring and describing familiar places and why some places are special to different people. Our particular focus will be on our Farrer community. We will be undertaking community walks to identify special places in Farrer. Stay tuned for a special Kindergarten project where we will be constructing a special space within our school!



Japanese:

“HARAPEKO AOMUSHI”. This term, Kinder students will experience more Japanese vocabulary to assist with the interaction of teacher and peers using formulaic expressions from the book “The Hungry Caterpillar”. They will begin reading and writing in Japanese, including some kanji and copying some words in hiragana. Finally, they will begin describing objects using colour, size and shape words.
