

Mathematics



In mathematics lessons this term we will learn about maps and locations, aligning with our geography work in HASS. Students will learn to locate positions on maps and will create their own maps.

We will explore how money values can be represented in various ways. Students will also learn about angles and recognising them in real situations, as well as exploring symmetry in the environment.

We will continue to work on number facts working with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Welcome to what will be a very busy Term 3. After acknowledging NAIDOC Week in week 2, we will enjoy the Athletics Carnival in week 4 and a heads up to get costumes ready for Book Week in week 6! We will start both library visits and buddies this term.

HASS

In HASS this term we will inquire into 'diversity' as a geographical concept, exploring Australia's biomes and landscapes before we learn about Australia's closest neighbours. We will compare environments, animals, people and climates of countries including Indonesia, Malaysia, Papua New Guinea and New Zealand with Australia.

The Arts

Our visual arts units this term will align with our focus on Australia's diversity in HASS. Students will learn about printmaking through the work of Australian artists Margaret Preston and Bridget Farmer. In the second part of the term, we will learn about Australian artist Pete Cromer and explore collage making.

English



We will continue to focus on the components of reading, writing, spelling, speaking and listening every day. Students have opportunities to write each day, participating in whole class, modelled, guided and independent writing sessions.

Our writing focus this term will be on sentence-level writing before we move onto creating paragraphs. Students will have the choice to create a variety of texts as we align writing with our geography unit in HASS.

We will publish our writing with the purpose to engage, persuade and entertain our audience.

We will learn spelling concepts and explore vocabulary in context with focus texts. We will engage in regular spelling activities throughout the week in response to individual student needs.

Health/P.E.

In PE this term, students will participate in a variety of net / wall games. We will be using a games sense approach to learn about the tactics and strategies involved in these games. We will also focus on some of the fundamental movement skills used in net / wall games.

The Year Threes will be starting a Physics unit on heat energy. They will be learning about the properties of heat energy, how it is conducted and transferred and how it transforms. The students will continue to learn how atoms are affected by energy. They will use their knowledge of the properties of heat to suggest ways to improve the energy rating of the Environment Centre classroom. Classes will also be participating in preparation for our Spring planting in our Environment Centre gardens.
