| Purpose of excursion | The bike ride is a special excursion planned as a way of saying thank you to the students who have committed their time and energy to the care of our animals and gardens over the year.   |  |  |
| Transport            | <ul> <li>Bicycles. Where possible, students are expected to provide their own bike.</li> <li>Bikes will be checked for roadworthiness prior to leaving.</li> <li>Please ensure your child's bike and helmet are in good working order to save disappointment on the day if either does not pass our safety check.</li> <li>**Important: Due to a general shortage of staff, parents/carers are responsible for transporting students back to school in the event of problems with bikes, illness or behaviour. Please note that this needs to be agreed to on the permission form for your child to attend.</li> </ul> |  |  |
| Attending Staff      | <ul> <li>The school has some bikes that can be used, but numbers are limited. | What to bring        | <ul> <li>A backpack that is easy to ride with to carry morning tea, a hat, sunscreen and a FULL water bottle.</li> <li>The Kids Kitchen (canteen) is offering a catered lunch to be delivered to the place space.</li> <li>This will include a hotdog, juice box, cookie and a Zooper Dooper for \$3.00 per child.</li> <li>Regular, halal and vegetarian hotdogs are available.</li> <li>Please order through the 'Spriggy Schools App' under 'EVENTS' by MONDAY 11 December, 6pm.</li> <li>Alternatively, students can also carry their own lunches in their backpacks.</li> </ul>                                   |  |  |
| What to wear         | Full school uniform. Comfortable riding shoes. A helmet must be worn when riding and a hat for all other times.  |  |  |

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.

Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, willful or disobedient behaviour.

If students choose to engage in behaviours which are considered inappropriate and harmful to others, they will be returned to their homes and the costs involved will be the responsibility of the parents.

The ACT Education Directorate does not provide any insurance cover for injury, disease or illness to students resulting from school activities or schoolorganised excursions. Claims for compensation are met where there is a legal liability to do so. Liability is not automatic and depends on the circumstances in which any injury, disease or illness was sustained.

As there is no automatic insurance cover for personal injury if your child is injured at school or during a school organised activity/excursion you should therefore consider whether taking out personal insurance cover for your child is warranted.

This insurance might cover contingencies including medical/hospital expenses, ambulance transport outside the ACT, and cancellation of transport/accommodation or loss of/damage to luggage.

The ACT Ambulance Service provides free ambulance transport for students who are injured or suddenly become ill at school or during an approved school organised activity within the ACT
