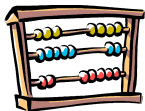


Mathematics

Science - Kate Elliot

In chemistry Year 1 students will be learning that everyday materials can be changed in a variety of ways. They will investigate changes that materials undergo when temperature and moisture levels are affected. Students will participate in cooking, growing yeast and observing changes made by freezing various materials. Students will relate this learning to scientific inventions that can preserve food.

English



Our daily literacy block focuses on the components of reading, writing, spelling, speaking and listening. Students have opportunities to write each day, participating in whole class, modelled, guided and independent writing sessions.

This term, during interactive writing and writer's workshop students will learn to write texts that entertain. Students will learn the structure of narrative texts through the study of mentor texts by authors such as Mem Fox and Leigh Hobbs. Students will demonstrate their learning and understanding through an integrated written narrative about a family member.

History

This term, students will explore how their world is different from the past. Using the inquiry model students will answer questions like: Why and how are toys, transport and communication different? Students will create questions about the recent past and collect and interpret information and data from grandparent or family friend.
