Welcome to Term 2! We have a busy term ahead with lots of activities on.

Students will participate in Rostrum public speaking competition, as well as different sporting carnivals that will take place. We will be continuing with our Parliament sittings every couple of weeks

History

Students will be learning about figures and events that have shaped Australia as a nation since Federation. Linking closely to English, students will develop their research and inquiry skills to write a biography on a famous Australian and report on a significant event within the last century.

Health/P.E.

This term we will be focusing on ball sports, including basketball and netball. Students will have the opportunity continue developing teamwork and sportsmanship skills

Japanese

Nihon ni ikimashou...Let's go to Japan! This term Year 6 students discover a range of famous places in different cities around Japan. They will interact with each other expressing where they would like to go/what they would like to eat, etc. We focus on hiragana writing using the hiragana charts and correct stroke order to write extended paragraphs using conjunctions.

Environment Centre / Science

In chemistry, students will be learning about chemical and physical changes. They will be discussing the importance of clean drinking water and how drinking water can be filtered and cleaned. Students will experiment with various materials and processes for water filtration and use their results to build a water filter using soda bottles.

English



This term students will continue developing their knowledge and skills in writing, with a focus on biographies. Students will continue planning, drafting, proofreading and editing their writing. There will be a variety of opportunities for students to publish and share their writing.

During whole class reading activities, students will learn different strategies that will help them deepen and retain their understanding of what they read. Specific strategies that will be focused on include summarising and paraphrasing, gathering facts, important versus interesting information and looking at primary and secondary sources

Students will participate in rostrum in order to develop their public speaking skills as well as whole class discussions and parliamentary question times.

The Arts - Music

In visual art this term students will discuss what a 'portrait' is and how its definition has changed over time. They will experiment with a range of elements and processes to trial and practice new and existing skills. Students will be given the opportunity to design and create their own portrait art.
