



## Mathematics

## Year 3 - Term 3 - 2021

There'll be lots of exciting learning to come in Term 3. We also have the Athletics Carnival in week 5. Book Week is this term and the Book Fair is scheduled for Week 6. The Science Fair is also this term so start thinking about and working on your project.

### HASS

In HASS we will explore the topic of 'Civics and Citizenship'. We will cover voting, the difference between rules and laws and how citizens contribute to their communities. Key questions will be 'How do we make decisions fairly?', 'What is a rule and who decides them?' and 'What communities am I a part of?'

### The Arts - Performing Arts

Our Art this term will be performing arts. We will be looking at ways we can expressive ourselves using facial features, body language and voice modulations. We will practice these skills through small performances, drama games and reader's theatre.



## English



Our writing focus for this term is 'Writing to persuade'.

We will be looking at the structures of different persuasive texts, analyzing and evaluating their language features, and applying what we've learnt to our own writing.

When finished, we will publish a piece of writing with the purpose to persuade and teach the readers.

The spelling program we will continue to use in Year 3 is 'Words Their Way'. We will engage in regular spelling rotations throughout the week in relation to individual needs.

## Health/P.E

In PE this term, students will participate in an athletics unit where they will practice and refine the fundamental movement skills of running, jumping and throwing. Students will apply these skills in activities, simple games and group challenges. Later in the term students will use a "games sense" approach to learn about the tactics and strategies involved in striking and fielding games. We will also focus on some of the movement skills used in striking and fielding games such as striking, throwing, and catching. Students will demonstrate and apply these skills and strategies in active play, movement challenges and striking and fielding games.

## Environment Centre/Science:

The Year Three's will be starting a Physics unit on heat energy. They will be learning about the properties of heat energy, how it is conducted and transferred and how it can be transformed. The students will continue to learn how atoms are affected by energy. They will use their knowledge of the properties of heat to suggest ways to improve the energy rating of the Environment Centre classroom. Classes will also be participating in preparation for our Spring planting in our Environment Centre gardens.

## Japanese

This term, Year 3 will be learning dialogue around the topic of 'kimono'. You would know this word refers to the beautiful traditional Japanese clothing item, but it literally means "thing to wear". Students will learn the vocabulary for modern and traditional clothing and how to talk about these items using some simple phrases.
