

## Mathematics



This term throughout maths lessons children will continue to explore concepts using a hands on and open ended approach.

Kindergarten children will revise number topics such as addition and subtraction strategies and sharing and making groups. Children will also inquire into patterns, data collection, money and positional language.

## Physical Education and Health

In PE this term, Kindergarten students will participate in a range of movement and skill challenges during learning from home. At school, students will continue to develop fundamental movement skills while participating in a range of physical activities, games and movement challenges. Students will work to develop personal and social skills to play safely and fairly and include others. They will identify different settings where they can be active and describe how bodies respond to movement.

We are impressed by the growth students have made during the learning at home period. We look forward to being back in the classroom soon. Term 4 is always busy and before we know it, it will be the end of the year.

## Geography and Science



This term we will be completing our geography unit 'Special Places'. We have enjoyed hearing about all the places which are important to children and will be focusing on our 'Farrer School Space' to finish off our learning.

We are very lucky to have received tadpoles from Frogwatch ACT. Over the next 11 weeks students will have the opportunity to watch the tadpoles grow into frogs. We will be researching life cycles and the needs of living things through a science inquiry unit.

**Science with Jan Elliot** - Kindergarten students will understand that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples have long standing scientific knowledge and traditions and developed knowledge about the world. We will investigate how Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples gain knowledge about the land and its vital resources, such as water and food through observation.

## English



**Reading, writing, listening, speaking and viewing.**

Through the English Curriculum we will continue to expose the children to a wide range of group activities involving reading, writing, speaking, viewing and listening.

Classes will continue to focus on sounds, letter recognition and sentence construction using the literature we are reading in class.

Learning will happen through a variety of small group and whole class reading and writing activities.

This term we will be exploring 'writing to entertain' and will be learning about narratives and focussing on characters, setting and practising sequencing the orientation, complication and resolution.

Recognising and reading high frequency words, referred to as Magic 100 words will continue through word work activities and can be supported by practise at home.
