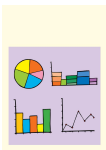
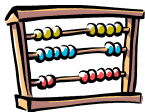


Mathematics

The Arts

Students will use and experiment with different materials, techniques, technologies and processes to make artworks. They will compare the qualities and properties of materials such as found objects and select appropriate applications to represent something.

Japanese

Konnichiwa! The topic for this term is "My Family". Students will learn how to talk about their family and pets using simple sentence patterns. There will be some grammar development such as how to count people and how to indicate ownership. Lessons involve games, songs, stories, role-plays, written work and more.

Science - Jan Elliot

Students will use their senses to observe and explore the natural features of the sky and landscape. They will develop their understanding that the environment is constantly changing, that these changes occur over varying periods of time and that some changes are due to natural processes and others due to human activity. Students will recognise that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples have long had an extensive knowledge of daily and seasonal changes, weather patterns and landscape.

Chemistry - Class teachers

Students will explore how we use twisting, stretching and bending to physically change the shape of everyday materials.

English



Our daily literacy block focuses on the components of reading, writing, spelling, speaking and listening. Students have opportunities to write each day, participating in whole class, modelled, guided and independent writing sessions. This term, during interactive writing and writer's workshop students will learn to write texts that inform. Students will learn the structure of informative texts through the study of mentor texts on koalas, emus and Tasmanian devils. Students will demonstrate their learning and understanding by researching, writing and presenting a weather report on the different seasons of Kakadu.

Health / P.E.

In PE this term, students will focus on object control, using large balls to develop the fundamental movement skills of rolling, two-hand throwing, catching and bouncing. Students will demonstrate strategies to work in groups and play fairly during various activities, games and through solving moving challenges.

Geography

This term, we continue our learning on Places and Spaces. We will look at daily and seasonal weather patterns of Ngannawal land, Canberra and those of other places. We will inquire into how seasonal change is perceived by different cultures. We will also look at how the features of places change and why and how spaces within places can be arranged.
