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## YEAR 5/6 CAMP TO COAST LIFE ADVENTURES, KIANINNY BUSH COTTAGES

Dear Families,

Next term, Year 5/6 will be travelling to Coast Life Adventures for a three-day camp from Wednesday 1 September to Friday 3 September 2021. The Coast Life program operates from Tathra NSW, and students will be staying at Kianinny Bush Cottages. The staff at Coast Life have tailored a program specifically for our Year 5/6 students at Farrer Primary School. Students will engage in a variety of individual and team challenges designed to develop skills in decision-making, problem-solving, leadership, self-confidence, self-awareness and teamwork. The program will complement many of the 2021 units of work and whole school initiatives including our social skills program.

Intended learning outcomes:

- develop skills to work cooperatively as a team member;
- develop personal growth and self esteem;
- develop independence through challenge; and
- develop leadership skills.

**Location:** Kianinny Bush Cottages

**Time:** Arrive at school at 7:30am on 1 September  
Depart at 8:00am on 1 September  
Return at 3:00pm approximately on 3 September

**Transport:** Sapphire Coast Coach Company (Bus)

**What to bring:** a list of requirements will be sent home on Week 1, Term 3 with required medical forms

**Cost:** **\$385 (Payment due Friday 20 August 2021)**

**Notes are due back:** Friday 13 August 2021

**Permission notes will not be accepted after this date because we are required to give final numbers to Coast Life Adventures two weeks prior to the camp.**

The teacher in charge will be Jodie White. Other staff accompanying the group will be Cameron Sant, Georgie Kelley, Michael Tinio, Amy Carr and Andrew Gibson.

Please note: *The school is organising the Year 5/6 camp to Coast Life Adventures, as an optional activity. Full payment is therefore required from each participating student in order to cover the costs. If the school is unable to cover the costs, the school may not be able to provide the activity. Please talk to your child's teacher or Ms Liz Wallace if you are experiencing difficulty with payments. Individual records of contributions are confidential.*

Program Activities include:

- surf safety;
- flying fox;
- raft building;
- canoeing; and
- team building games.

If you wish to contact the group in an emergency, you can phone the school or call **Coast Life Adventures on 02 64941122**.

In the event of an emergency, staff will contact you by phone (**please ensure that the school has up-to-date contact records for you – both day and night contacts are needed**). If immediate medical attention is necessary, it will be sought from the nearest appropriate medical facility and we will advise you as soon as possible.

Parents may be required to collect a sick child if the nominated first aid officer feels that this is the most appropriate form of action.

Parents and carers should note that free ambulance transportation only applies in the ACT; therefore, you are reminded to check your health cover for ambulance transportation outside the ACT.

Staff accompanying students on camp will take all reasonable care while the students are in their care to protect them from injury and to supervise their behaviours and activities. Parents may be called to take their child home if a student is putting themselves or another child's camp experience at risk.

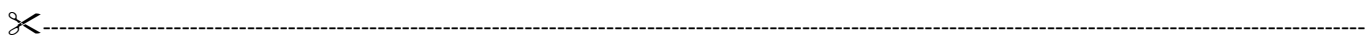
